- Conducting interactive sessions with representatives of Sudanese refugees in the UNHCR camps in Eastern Chad.
- Consulting NGOs, Media and legal communities concerned with the crisis in Darfur in Europe and Chad.

The session aimed to explain the work of the Court with regards to the Situation in Darfur and the rights of victims, women and children before the Court.
