## **I. Introduction**

1. The Registry hereby informs Pre-Trial Chamber II that Mr Cyril Laucci has been appointed as Duty Counsel by letter dated 11 June 2020, to represent Mr Ali Muhammad Al Abd-Al-Rahman (“Ali Kushayb”) within the context of his initial appearance before the International Criminal Court (“the Court”).

## **II. Classification**

2. The present submission and its Annex II are classified as public, whereas Annex I hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”) as it contains the private contact details of Mr Laucci.

## **III. Applicable Law**

3. The following provisions are of particular relevance to the present submission: article 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis*, 67, 69 and 73 of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), regulations 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).


## **IV. Submissions**
