I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs Pre-Trial Chamber II that Mr Cyril Laucci has been appointed as Duty Counsel by letter dated 11 June 2020, to represent Mr Ali Muhammad Al Abd-Al-Rahman ("Ali Kushayb") within the context of his initial appearance before the International Criminal Court ("the Court").

II. Classification

2. The present submission and its Annex II are classified as public, whereas Annex I hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court ("RoC") as it contains the private contact details of Mr Laucci.

III. Applicable Law

3. The following provisions are of particular relevance to the present submission: article 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23bis, 67, 69 and 73 of the Regulations of the Court ("RoC"), regulations 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel ("Code").

IV. Submissions

4. On 11 June 2020, the Registrar appointed Mr Laucci as Duty Counsel to represent Mr Ali Kushayb during his initial appearance before the Court.¹
