## **I. Introduction**

1. The Registry hereby informs Trial Chamber X (“Chamber”) of the appointment of Ms Leto Cariolou (“Ms Cariolou”) as Legal Adviser to Witness D-0529 (“Notification of Appointment”), pursuant to rule 74(10) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”).

## **II. Classification**

2. Pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), the annexes to the present submission are classified as confidential, as they contain personal information and contact details of Ms Cariolou.

## **III. Applicable Law**

3. The Registry has considered the following provisions: article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74(10) of the Rules, regulations 67 and 69 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel (“Code”).

## **IV. Submissions**

4. On 28 June 2022, the Chamber directed the Registry to appoint Rule 74 counsel for D-0529.<sup>1</sup>
5. On the same day, the Registrar appointed Ms Cariolou as the Legal Adviser to Witness D-0529.<sup>2</sup> Ms Cariolou will be duly provided with access to relevant material in connection with the case, including the statements and transcripts of



interviews of Witness D-0529, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain confidentiality at all times.<sup>3</sup>

6. Ms Cariolou has previously executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code.<sup>4</sup>
