Background

The witness is a [REDACTED] year old Sudanese male. He and his family currently reside in [REDACTED]. The VWU interviewed him on 10 June 2022, for the purpose of an in-court protective measures assessment.

Witness's concern

The witness stated that some of his relatives are [REDACTED]. He is concerned that they may be harmed, if his testimony before the Court is made public.

The VWU explained to the witness the various procedural protective measures that the Court may implement to mitigate risks that may emanate from his testimony. He requested the VWU to inform the Court to consider granting him procedural protective measures to hide his identity.

Protection Analysis

The witness and his immediate family are currently residing in [REDACTED], which is outside the identified area of risk. [REDACTED]. Consequently, the VWU considers that implementation of procedural protective measures to ensure that the witness's identity is not publicized during his testimony before the Court, may mitigate potential risk to his relatives [REDACTED], that may emanate from his testimony.

Recommendations

The VWU recommends that the Court consider granting the witness the following in-court protective measures: use of pseudonyms, image and voice distortion, use of closed and/or private session when needed, and redaction of any identifying information from the Court's records before dissemination to the public.
