Kindly be informed that, in accordance with its assessment of vulnerable witnesses, the psychologist of the Victims and Witnesses Unit has conducted a vulnerability assessment of witness DAR-OTP-P-0718.

After the assessment, the VWU psychologist recommends the following special measures according to Rule 88 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence:

1. Measures to adapt the questioning to the needs and capacities of the witness

1.1. Observe the witness closely; in case of signs of nervousness, distraction, withdrawal or too emotional reactions a break is allowed or witness is asked if he needs a break

2. Provide reading assistance for text

2.1. The witness is illiterate. He should, therefore, not be asked to read or write anything in the courtroom and should be provided with reading assistance
