Dear Colleagues,

Kindly be informed that, in accordance with its assessment of vulnerable witnesses, the psychologist of the Victims and Witnesses Unit has conducted a vulnerability assessment of witness **DAR-OTP-P-0718**.

After the assessment, the VWU psychologist recommends the following special measures according to Rule 88 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence:

1. Measures to adapt the questioning to the needs and capacities of the witness

1.1. *Observe the witness closely; in case of signs of nervousness, distraction, withdrawal or too emotional reactions a break is allowed or witness is asked if he needs a break*

2. Provide reading assistance for text

2.1. *The witness is illiterate. He should, therefore, not be asked to read or write anything in the courtroom and should be provided with reading assistance*
