THE PRESIDENCY of the International Criminal Court (hereinafter "Court");

NOTING the document in support of appeal filed on 12 March 2012 by the Prosecutor against the "Decision on the Confirmation of charges" in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Callixte Mbarushimana* (hereinafter "appeal");²

NOTING that on 15 March 2012 the Presidency decided that, for the purpose of the appeal, the Appeals Chamber was to be composed of Judges Sang-Hyun Song, Akua Kuenyehia, Erkki Kourula, Anita Ušacka and Ekaterina Trendafilova;³

NOTING the request of Judge Trendafilova of 16 March 2012 to be excused from exercising her functions as a judge of the Appeals Chamber in the appeal (hereinafter "Request") pursuant to article 41 of the Rome Statute and rule 33 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (hereinafter "Rules");⁴

NOTING the decision of the Presidency of 21 March 2012, excusing Judge Trendafilova from the Appeals Chamber;⁵

CONSIDERING rule 38 of the Rules providing for the replacement of judges;

CONSIDERING regulation 15 of the Regulations of the Court, pursuant to which the Presidency is responsible for the replacement of judges in accordance with article 39 of the Statute, and regulation 12 of the Regulations of the Court, further to which the Presidency shall, in the event that a member of the Appeals Chamber is disqualified, or unavailable for a substantial reason, attach to the Appeals Chamber, on a temporary basis, a judge from either the Trial or Pre-Trial Division;
