Pursuant to PTC A's Decision ICC-01/09-01/15-62, dated 11-12-2020, this document is retained in the Case File ICC-01/09-01/15: The Prosecutor v. Philip Kipkoech Bett.

Pre-Trial Chamber II, following a request of the Prosecutor filed on 28 August 2015 (ICC-01/09-01/15-10-US-Exp), issues the present order reclassifying the warrant of arrest and other documents in the record of the case.

The Chamber notes, on the basis of the information provided by the Prosecutor, that Paul Gicheru and Philip Kipkoech Bett were arrested on 30 July 2015 by the Kenyan police in Nairobi, Kenya, in execution of the Court's request for arrest and surrender, and were presented before a Judge of the High Court of Kenya in accordance with Kenyan law. Since the arrest has taken place and since Paul Gicheru and Philip Kipkoech Bett were made aware of the Court's warrant of arrest, the restrictive level of classification of that and other documents in the record of the case is no longer justified. In accordance with regulation 23 *bis* (3) of the Regulations of the Court, bearing in mind the need to protect the confidentiality of certain information under articles 57(3)(c) and 68(1) of the Statute, documents in the record of the warrant of arrest is filed simultaneously.
