Trial Chamber I

**THE PRESIDENCY** of the International Criminal Court (the 'Court');

**NOTING** article 61(11) of the Statute, pursuant to which the Presidency shall constitute a Trial Chamber once the charges have been confirmed, which shall be responsible for the conduct of subsequent proceedings, and Rule 130 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the 'Rules') whereby the Presidency shall refer the case to a Trial Chamber and transmit to it the Decision Confirming the Charges and the record of the proceedings of the Pre-Trial Chamber;

**NOTING** the decision of Pre-Trial Chamber II dated 9 July 2021 which, *inter alia*, confirmed, pursuant to article 61(7)(a) of the Statute, charges presented by the Prosecutor against Mr Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman in the case *The Prosecutor v. Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman*, to the extent specified at pages 50 to 70 of that decision, and committed him to a Trial Chamber for trial on the charges as confirmed (the 'Decision Confirming the Charges');<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** that the Decision Confirming the Charges ordered that the record of the proceedings be immediately transmitted to the Presidency;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** that the record of the proceedings before Pre-Trial Chamber II and the Decision Confirming the Charges were formally transmitted to the Presidency by the Registrar on 16 July 2021, in accordance with rule 129 of the Rules;<sup>3</sup>

**NOTING** the Presidency's previous decision assigning judges to divisions and recomposing Chambers, in which it, *inter alia*, dissolved Trial Chamber I;<sup>4</sup>

**NOTING** further that when composing chambers, the Presidency must balance a number of factors to the extent necessary and possible, and that the guiding principles informing these

factors are the applicable statutory framework and the need to ensure the efficient management of the Court's workload, including in view of the Court's long-term needs;

**CONSIDERING** the current and anticipated overall judicial workload of the Court and the necessity to ensure sound management of the same, the need to expedite proceedings, the workload and individual concerns of the respective judges, their previous involvement in cases, as well as the experience and expertise of each judge;

## **HEREBY CONSITUTES** Trial Chamber I as follows:

Judge Reine Alapini-Gansou

Judge Joanna Korner

Judge Althea Violet Alexis-Windsor;

**DECIDES** to call Judge Joanna Korner and Judge Althea Violet Alexis-Windsor to serve on a full-time basis, in accordance with article 35(3) of the Statute, in view of their extensive experience as trial judges, noting that the existing judicial resources at the Court are insufficient to meet the needs at trial level of the present case;

**DECIDES** to refer the case of *The Prosecutor v. Ali Muhammad Ali Abd-Al-Rahman ('Ali Kushayb')* to Trial Chamber I;

**ORDERS** the Registrar, pursuant to rule 130 of the Rules, to transmit the full record of the proceedings in the above mentioned case to Trial Chamber I, including the Decision Confirming the Charges and to notify the present decision to the relevant parties and participants in the case.
