August 2006, in which the victims apply to participate inter alia in the status

conferences of 5 and 19 September 2006;

**NOTING** the "Decision authorising the Prosecutor and the Defence to respond to the

observations of the legal representatives regarding the manner in which victims

a/0001/06 a/0002/06, a/0002/06 and a/0003/06 are to participate in the hearing to

confirm the charges"2 issued on 10 August 2006 by Judge Sylvia Steiner acting as

single judge for Pre-Trial Chamber I ("the Chamber");
