- On 19 November 2009, Trial Chamber I ("Trial Chamber" or "Chamber") of the International Criminal Court ("Court" or "ICC"), in the case of The Prosecutor v. Thomas Lubanga Dyilo, rendered its Second Decision on disclosure by the defence and Decision on whether the prosecution may contact defence witnesses¹.
- 2. In order to consider any administrative matters related to this Decision, the Trial Chamber hereby schedules a status conference with the attendance of the Office of the Prosecutor and the defence for **Wednesday 9 December 2009 at 10.30.** 
  - 3. Thereafter, the Trial Chamber further schedules a public status conference on Wednesday 9 December 2009 with the attendance of the parties, participants and the Victims and Witness Unit. An agenda for this hearing will be circulated shortly.
  - Subject to an Appeals Chamber decision being issued prior to the Court recess, the recommencement of the trial is provisionally set for Wednesday, 6 January 2010.
