**CONSIDERING** that approximately 1000 applications are being processed by the Registry 10% of which will have to be completed at a later stage;


**CONSIDERING** therefore that an approximate number of 850 to 900 applications will be submitted in the coming weeks for participation in the proceedings;

**CONSIDERING** that 218 of those applications have now been processed and redacted in accordance with the guidelines established by the Chamber;

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry will transmit these 218 applications in redacted form to the parties and the legal representatives of the applicants in accordance with the Chamber's instructions;

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry will also prepare and transmit to the Chamber an individual report for each of the applications annexed to this report;

**TRANSMITS** the 218 applications to participate in the proceedings to the Chamber.
