**NOTING** the “Decision setting a time-limit for the submission of new victims’ applications for participation” issued by Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”);<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86(5) of the Regulations of the Court;

**CONSIDERING** that 953 applications to participate in the proceedings have already been transmitted to the Chamber on 24 September 2010, 1 October 2010, 8 October 2010 and 15 October 2010;<sup>2</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that 280 further applications received before the deadline established by the Chamber<sup>3</sup> have now been processed and redacted in accordance with the guidelines established by the Chamber;

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry will transmit these 280 applications in redacted form to the parties and the legal representatives of the applicants in accordance with the Chamber’s instructions;

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry will also prepare and transmit to the Chamber an individual report for each of the applications annexed to this report;


