- 1. On 8 March 2011, the Chamber, by majority, decided to summon Francis Kirimi Muthaura, Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta and Mohammed Hussein Ali to appear before the Court on 7 April 2011.<sup>1</sup>
- 2. On 18 March 2011, the Chamber decided that the initial appearance hearing shall be convened on Friday, 8 April 2011 at 14.30 hours.<sup>2</sup>
- 3. On 31 March 2011, the Chamber received the "Application on Behalf of the Government of the Republic of Kenya Pursuant to Article 19 of the ICC Statute" (the "Kenyan Application" or the "Application")<sup>3</sup>.
- 4. On 4 April 2011, the Single Judge rendered the decision concerning the conduct of the proceedings<sup>4</sup> whereby the Court requested the Prosecution and the Defence to submit written observations on the Kenyan Application, no later than Thursday 28 April 2011, at 16.00 hours.<sup>5</sup>
- 5. The Defence of Mohammed Hussein Ali makes no representations with respect to the Application of the Government of Kenya Pursuant to Article 19 of the Rome Statute.
- 6. The Defence reserves its right to raise legal challenges envisaged under the Statute, including applications pursuant to Article 19 of the Statute.
