

1. The Government of Libya hereby re-files its six Public Annexes to its 'Application on behalf of the Government of Libya pursuant to Article 19 of the ICC Statute' ("Admissibility Challenge"). Most of these Annexes were originally filed in draft translation form along with the Libyan Government's Admissibility Challenge on 1 May 2012.
2. This re-filing is made pursuant to Article 50 of the ICC Statute, and Regulations 23 and 39 of the Court, and is designed to ensure that the Chamber, the parties and other participants in these proceedings have the benefit of perfected, rather than draft, translations of all of the Public Annexes to Libya's Admissibility Challenge.
