
The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (“the Court”);

NOTING Trial Chamber V’s (the “Chamber”) Decision on victims’ representation and participation notified on 3 October 2012 (the “3 October Decision”), instructing the Victims Participation and Reparation Section (the “VPRS”) to treat the applications falling within the scope of the present case as having been registered and make them available to the Common Legal Representative;¹

NOTING the Chamber’s Decision notified on 23 November 2012, appointing Mr Wilfred Nderitu as Common Legal Representative in the present case (the “23 November Decision”);²

CONSIDERING that on 9 January 2013 the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”) requested the VPRS to transmit all applications related to the victims represented by the Office up until the 23 November Decision to Mr. Wilfred Nderitu;³

INFORMS the Chamber and the parties that on 18 January 2013 the VPRS transmitted all of the applications formerly represented by the OPCV to Mr. Wilfred Nderitu.
