NOTING Pre-Trial Chamber II’s Decision on victims’ participation notified on 5 August 2011, accepting 327 victims to participate at the confirmation of charges stage;¹

NOTING Pre-Trial Chamber II’s Decision to confirm the charges notified on 23 January 2012;²

NOTING Trial Chamber V’s (the “Chamber”) Decision on victims’ representation and participation notified on 3 October 2012 (the “3 October Decision”), directing the Victims Participation and Reparation Section (the “VPRS”) to file every two months, in cooperation with the Common Legal Representative, once appointed, a comprehensive report on the general situation of victims as a whole, including statistics about the victims’ population and information in relation to registered and non-registered victims;³


