

1. On 9 September 2013, the Prosecution applied to include additional items on its List of Evidence.¹ After receiving submissions from the Defence² and further submissions from the Prosecution,³ Trial Chamber V(A) ("Chamber") permitted the inclusion of 104 extra items on the Prosecution's List of Evidence.⁴ The Chamber ordered, *inter alia*, that the Prosecution file the updated List of Evidence into the record of the case within seven days of notification of the Decision, which was 17 October.

2. In compliance with the Chamber's order, the Prosecution hereby files as Annex 1 a confidential *ex parte*, Prosecution and VWU only version of its updated List of Evidence. The Prosecution will simultaneously file a confidential redacted version of Annex 1.

3. Pursuant to Regulation 23bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court, the Prosecution files Annex 1 as "confidential, ex parte, Prosecution and VWU only" as it contains confidential personal information relating to witnesses.
