#### I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Defence for Uhuru Kenyatta ('Defence') hereby notifies Trial Chamber V(B) ('Chamber') that, after consultation with Counsel, Mr Kenyatta reviewed and signed the waiver of his right to be present at trial. A copy of the waiver is attached at Annex A and is filed confidentially as it pertains to the waiver of Mr Kenyatta's personal right and contains personal information. The original signed waiver is filed with the Registry concurrently.

# II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY

- 2. On 3 September 2013, the Defence notified the Chamber that it wished to raise the issue of Mr Kenyatta's conditional excusal from trial at the status conference on 6 September 2013.<sup>1</sup>
- 3. On 6 September 2013, the Defence made an oral application for Mr Kenyatta's excusal from continuous presence at trial.<sup>2</sup> The Prosecution and Common Legal Representative of the Victims opposed the application.<sup>3</sup>
- 4. On 23 September 2013, the Defence filed the 'Defence Request for Conditional Excusal from Continuous Presence at Trial.' <sup>4</sup> On 1 October 2013, the Prosecution <sup>5</sup> and Common Legal Representative of the Victims <sup>6</sup> filed submissions opposing the Defence's request.

5. On 18 October 2013, the Chamber, by majority, partially granted the Defence's request. <sup>7</sup> The Chamber stipulated that: Mr Kenyatta must be physically present in the courtroom for certain specified hearings; Mr Kenyatta's absence must be directed towards the performance of his duties of State; and the Defence must file a waiver of Mr Kenyatta's right to be present at trial with the Registry.

# III. SUBMISSIONS

6. The Defence hereby submits at Confidential Annex A a copy of Mr Kenyatta's waiver of his right to be present at trial.
