NOTING the notification to the Defence of applications for reparations under rule 94(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence” (the “Rules”), notified on 13 January 2011 (the “Notification”);<sup>1</sup>

NOTING the instruction of Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”), conveyed by email on 11 November 2013,<sup>2</sup> that the Registry should reclassify as confidential *ex parte*, only available to the Defence and the Legal Representatives of the Applicant, the redacted annexes of the Notification;

NOTING the instruction of the Chamber, conveyed by email on 11 May 2012, that the Registry should notify the applications for reparations notified to the Defence under rule 94(2) of the Rules also to the Legal Representatives designated in the application form or, in case no Legal Representative is designated, the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (the “OPCV”);<sup>3</sup>

NOTING the instructions of the Chamber, conveyed by email on 2 August 2012, ordering the Registry to notify by way of a filing the designation of the OPCV as Legal Representative of unrepresented applicants;<sup>4</sup>
