Introduction

Submission

- 4. On 23 October 2017, the Registrar appointed Mr David Josse as Legal Adviser to Witness P-0067.¹
- 5. Mr Josse was duly provided with electronic access to relevant material in connection with the case, including the statements and transcripts of interviews of Witness P-0067, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain confidentiality at all times.²
