### **INTRODUCTION**

- 1. On 16 March 2018, the presentation of evidence was closed.<sup>2</sup>
- 2. On 14 May 2018, the Defence requested the admission into evidence of items used during the testimony of Mr Ntaganda (DRC-D18-0001-5683, DRC-D18-0001-5748 and DRC-D18-0001-5778) which had not been tendered into evidence due to an oversight.<sup>3</sup>
- 3. On 21 May 2018, the Prosecution filed its response, not opposing the Defence Request.<sup>4</sup>
- 4. On 22 May 2018, the Chamber granted the Defence Request and directed the Defence, in coordination with the Prosecution, to file, within one week of notification of the Decision, submissions on the appropriate confidentiality level for the items admitted by way of the Decision.
