- 1. Pursuant to Regulation 78(1) of the Regulations of the Court, Lead Counsel for Mr. Abdallah Banda Abakaer Nourain ("Mr. Banda") before the International Criminal Court (ICC) respectfully requests the authorisation of the Trial Chamber to withdraw from his representation of Mr. Banda in case ICC-02/05-03/09.
- 2. Lead Counsel submits this request to withdraw as counsel further to his appointment, on 31 May 2018, as the United Nations Special Advisor and Head of the Investigative Team established pursuant to Security Council Resolution 2379 (2017). The nature of and responsibilities arising from this new mandate will result in Lead Counsel being unavailable to continue to represent Mr. Banda in the present case.
- 3. Lead Counsel respectfully advises the Chamber that further to discussions between Lead Counsel and the Counsel Support Section (CSS), if the Chamber is minded to grant this withdrawal request, Chief Charles Achaleke Taku, who was appointed an Associate Counsel on the Defence Team effective 11 July 2018, is available and may be appointed as Lead Counsel for Mr. Banda in case ICC-02/05-03/09.
- 4. In view of the Trial Chamber's decision of 11 September 2014² which, *inter alia*, vacated the date of trial and suspended preparatory measures for Mr. Banda's trial until Mr. Banda's appearance before the Court, Lead Counsel submits that the proposed change in the composition of Mr. Banda's legal team will not result in any procedural delays in the case.
