**Trial Chamber VI** of the International Criminal Court ('Chamber'), in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Bosco Ntaganda*, having regard to Article 64(10) of the Rome Statute, issues the following 'Order placing on the record the parties' submissions and email decision of 17 September 2019 on the request by the Prosecution for disclosure of a statement of Witness D-0305'.

- 1. On 16 September 2019, the Office of the Prosecutor ('Prosecution') requested, by email, for the disclosure of a statement of Witness D-0305, taken by the defence team for Mr Ntaganda ('Defence') in May 2019 ('Request'). The next day, the Defence responded, also by email.<sup>2</sup>
- 2. On 17 September 2019, the Chamber communicated to the parties and participants by email that it rejected the Request.<sup>3</sup> The Chamber placed this decision on the record during the public hearing held later that day.<sup>4</sup>
- 3. To ensure completeness of the case record, and in the interest of the publicity of the proceedings, the Chamber hereby places the relevant submissions and its decision, attached as confidential annexes to the present order, on the record of the case.
