I. Transmission

1. Pursuant to Pre-Trial Chamber III's "Decision on the 'Registry's Request for Extension of Notice Period and Submissions on the Article 15(3) Process'" issued on 28 June 2019,¹ the Registry hereby transmits 85 representation forms received from victims and victims' representatives in the Situation in the People's Republic of Bangladesh/Republic of the Union of Myanmar ("Situation"),² together with its assessment of these representations.³ In addition, the Registry is transmitting to the Chamber, via a TRIM container, 16 videos submitted in support of some representations.⁴


