## I. Transmission

1. Pursuant to Pre-Trial Chamber III's "Decision on the 'Registry's Request for Extension of Notice Period and Submissions on the Article 15(3) Process'" issued on 28 June 2019,<sup>1</sup> the Registry hereby transmits 23 representation forms received from victims and victims' representatives in the Situation in the People's Republic of Bangladesh/Republic of the Union of Myanmar ("Situation"), together with its assessment of these representations.<sup>2</sup> In addition, the Registry is transmitting to the Chamber, via a TRIM container, 26 video representations,<sup>3</sup> as well as one video submitted in support of one representation previously transmitted.<sup>4</sup>
2. The Registry notes that ten representations were received after the 28 October 2019 deadline. Out of these representations, two were previously transmitted to the Chamber<sup>5</sup> and seven are part of the present transmission.<sup>6</sup>

## II. Classification

3. Pursuant to regulation 23bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court, the annexes to the present document are classified as "confidential *ex parte*,


