I. Introduction

- 1. On 30 August 2017, the Single Judge of Trial Chamber IX ("Chamber") issued the "Decision on LRV Request Concerning the Deaths of Participating Victims", ("30 August 2017 Decision") ordering the Victims Participation and Reparations Section ("VPRS") to file an updated consolidated list of victims participating in the case of The Prosecutor v. Dominic Ongwen ("Ongwen case") "at least twice per calendar year until the conclusion of the proceedings before [the] Chamber." ¹
- 2. On 9 April 2018, pursuant to an order from the Chamber, ² the VPRS transmited the last updated consolidated list of the participating victims in the *Ongwen* case which took into account the change in legal representation of one participating victim and set the total number of participating victims at 4,100.³ The Registry has since informed the Chamber on 20 December 2018 and 14 June 2019 that no changes to the list of participating victims have occurred.
- 3. On 5 November 2019, the Legal Representatives of Victims ("LRVs") informed the VPRS that since the last report to the Chamber 35 participating victims have died.⁴ Accordingly, the total number of participating victims is now 4,065. ⁵ On 8 November 2019, the LRVs submitted 30 complete resumption of action forms which the VPRS has transmitted for the Chamber's consideration.

II. Submission

- 4. In accordance with paragraph 4(i) of the 30 August 2017 Decision, the VPRS is filing an updated consolidated list as Annex A that reflects the current status of victims participating in the proceedings.
- 5. In accordance with paragraph 4(ii) of the 30 August 2017 Decision, the 30 resumption of action forms received (including the necessary supporting materials) will be separately transmitted to the Chamber, parties and LRVs, with redactions applied as necessary. To facilitate the consideration of these resumption of action forms, the VPRS has appended a table as Annex B that sets out the basic contents of the resumption of action forms (including the requisite supporting materials) and includes the VPRS's assessment with respect to completeness.
- 6. Unless otherwise instructed, the VPRS will amend and file a list of participating victims that reflects the status of these 30 pending resumption of action forms in the next scheduled filing on 15 June 2020.
