## I. INTRODUCTION

The Registry hereby transmits to the Pre-Trial Chamber I (“the Chamber”) in accordance with Rule 13 (1) of the Rule of Procedure and Evidence, three documents received from Judge Fouad Baker, as instructed by the Chamber’s Senior Legal Officer on 13 March 2020<sup>1</sup>.

## II. Procedural History

1. On 20 February 2020, the Chamber issued its “Decision on Application for Leave to File Observations Pursuant to Rule 103 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence”<sup>2</sup>.
2. On 13 March 2020, the Court Management Section (“CMS”) received an e-mail from Judge Fouad Baker requesting the Registry to file a document (“Annex I”) before the Chamber<sup>3</sup>.
3. The same day, CMS contacted the Chamber requesting its guidance on how to register the document.
4. At 18:02, the Senior Legal Officer instructed CMS to submit the document *via* a Registry transmission filing<sup>4</sup>.
5. On 14 March 2020, CMS received two additional documents from Judge Fouad Baker (“Annexes II and III”) <sup>5</sup>.


