## I. Introduction

1. On 30 August 2017, the Single Judge of Trial Chamber IX (“Chamber”) issued the “Decision on LRV Request Concerning the Deaths of Participating Victims” (“30 August 2017 Decision”), ordering the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (“VPRS”) to file an updated consolidated list of victims participating in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Dominic Ongwen* “at least twice per calendar year until the conclusion of the proceedings before [the] Chamber.”<sup>1</sup>
2. On 13 December 2019, in accordance with paragraph 4(i) of the 30 August 2017 Decision, the VPRS filed an updated consolidated list of 4,065 victims that reflected the status of victims participating in the proceedings at that time.<sup>2</sup> In its filing, the VPRS announced that, unless instructed otherwise, it will amend and file, in June 2020, a list of participating victims that also reflects the status of 30 resumption of action forms<sup>3</sup> which were transmitted to the Chamber for its consideration on the same day.<sup>4</sup>

## II. Submission

3. The VPRS respectfully submits that during the reporting period, 14 December 2019 – 26 June 2020, no further applications for resumption of action were received<sup>5</sup> and no changes occurred in the legal representation of victims.


