CHAPTER ONE

INTRODUCTION

I. APPOINTMENT OF TEAM BY THE HON .ATTORNEY GENERAL

Following the Hon. Attorney General's directions to the Chief Public Prosecutor to constitute a team of State Counsel to undertake an update of cases related to the 2007 post election violence, the Chief Public Prosecutor nominated the following to undertake the said exercise:-

1. Muteti A. Muasya - SSC

2. Geoffrey M. Obiri - SC

3. George H. Murithi - SC

4. Mary I. Wang'ele - SC

5. Katherine M. Kithikii - SC

The Team was supported in its operations by:

1. Lucy Muhuni - Secretary

2. Victoria Njoha - Secretary

3. Ramadhan Wesonga - Librarian

3. Samson Mugaisi - Clerk

The Hon. Attorney General's approval for the commencement of the exercise was sought and granted on 8th March, 2011 and 15th March, 2011.

The details of the said Hon. Attorney General's and Solicitor General's approvals are contained in "Appendices 1A, 1B and 2"

The Chief Public Prosecutor convened a meeting of the members of the entire team on the 14th March, 2011where the terms of reference were agreed upon.

II.TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Terms of Reference agreed upon were to review and update:-

- all post election violence cases in court that were directed by the Attorney General to proceed to logical conclusion.
- all post election violence cases in court that were directed by the Attorney General to be withdrawn to allow further investigations.

- 3. all post election violence cases in court that were directed by the Hon. Attorney General to be withdrawn and the police files closed.
- 4. all post election violence cases under investigations, whose investigations files were submitted to Attorney general and on perusal the Attorney General directed that the files be sent back to the police for further investigation and resubmission on completion of the further investigations.
- 5. all post election violence inquests/inquiries files submitted to Attorney General which on perusal were returned to the police for further investigations and resubmission on completion of the investigation.
- 6. all post election violence sexual offences files submitted to the Attorney General for perusal and directions and returned for further investigation with directions to re-submit.
- Analyze the data collected then prepare and submit an updated report to the Hon. Attorney General within 10 days.

IV.METHODOLOGY

In order to achieve the desired objective of the exercise in line with the Terms of Reference, the Team developed a methodology as outlined hereunder:

- To procure relevant details from DCI and Provincial C.I.D officers of all cases handled by the C.I.D related to Post Election Violence.
- 2) To obtain the files, where necessary, from the police stations and bring them to the operation bases in Nairobi, Nakuru, Eldoret, Kisumu, Kakamega, and Mombasa.
- 3) To peruse the files and classify them as follows:
 - a) Cases related to post-election violence pending the arrest of known suspects.
 - b) Cases related to post-election violence that have been concluded and convictions rendered.
 - c) Cases related to post election violence which have been concluded and accused persons acquitted.
 - d) Inquest files.
 - e) Cases that were withdrawn following directions by the Hon. Attorney General.
 - f) Cases withdrawn at the instance of the police
 - g) Cases where accused persons were discharged.

Having agreed on the methodology, the Team commenced the exercise on 14th March, 2011.

The team has only been able to operate from Nairobi Headquarters since the commencement of the exercise awaiting facilitation to visit the field stations identified. Nevertheless, the team has received the necessary cooperation from the Commissioner of Police, PCIO's Western, Coast, Nyanza and Rift Valley Provinces who have all availed details of cases in their possession.

However, it is clear from the analysis of the information so far provided that there is an **urgent need for this team and the team constituted by the Commissioner of Police to hold a consultative meeting to harmonize the data**. This has been necessitated by a realization, on our part, that;

- Details of cases earlier on provided to the Hon. Attorney General's team and contained in the original report have not been captured in the subsequent updated report by the police.
- Details of cases contained in the updated police report indicate that there were cases that were not originally availed to the Attorney General's team on review of post election violence cases.
- Gender Based Violence Cases details were not contained in the original report but have now been supplied to the team.

- Inquest files opened in most stations still remain captured in the reports as "pending under investigations". This team is therefore unable to tell what is the status of the files for we have had no advantage of seeing and perusing the files.
- The team requires an update from the police team investigating the inquest files as to what difficulties they may be encountering in concluding those investigations.
- In some cases, inquests are indicated as having been concluded but there is no indication by the police what the respective courts found and or directed in those files.
- There are cases pending before court but the team cannot without the advantage of perusing the files tell where the proceedings have reached.
- In a considerable number of cases, the police have indicated that the same were withdrawn since the complainants could not be traced. This team would require evidence of the efforts made by the police to track down the complainants.

The following is an analysis of the data provided to the team.

CHAPTER TWO

GENDER BASED VIOLENCE CASES

In the report handed over to the Hon. Attorney General by the team on the review of post election violence related cases in Western, Nyanza, Central, Rift Valley, Easter, Coast and Nairobi Provinces on the 2 February, 2009, these category of cases was not covered. However, the DCI forwarded at total of filed for directions. The chief public prosecutor constituted a team which perused the files and forwarded the same to the Hon. Attorney General who directed in all files that the same be returned to the DCI for further investigations.

Our team requested the DCI vide our letter dated 15th March, 2011 for an update of all cases following in this category and of all cases falling in this category and in particular the sixty six (66) files. Following that request, Mr. Julius K. Ndegwa, EBS, DCP vide his letter reference number SCPOL.4.4.VOL.XXV.(25) forwarded two reports to the Chief Public Prosecutor to wit,

- Update on 2007 post election violence offences as of 4th May, 2010
- ii) Update on Gender Based Violence Cases(See Appendix 1 (C) and (D))

In regard to the report on Gender Based Violence Cases, the team analyzed the information contained thereof and noted the following:-

CHAPTER TEN

CONCLUSION

A.CHALLENGES

- The team was unable to review and prepare an updated report of all cases as anticipated because there was delay in submission of requested data to our headquarters from the police.
- The team was unable to visit the PCIO's offices within the period thus were constrained to rely on data relayed to the headquarters.
- Considering the nature, and urgency of the exercise, members of the Team were constrained to work long hours into the night including weekends.
- 4. Due to personnel constraints in the Department, the members of the Team had to undertake the exercise besides discharging their prosecutorial, administrative and other duties.

B.OBSERVATIONS

At this stage of the exercise, the Team has observed the following:-

- That, the agencies involved in fighting crime at the time of the post election violence were ill prepared for a crisis of the magnitude witnessed.
- 2. That there was, and still is, a lack of coordination by agencies dealing with the post election violence cases.
- 3. The police, in particular, were overwhelmed by the number of cases reported to them as demonstrated by the high number of cases pending further investigations.
- 4. The Rift Valley Province still remains the province with the highest number of reported cases. Despite the teams' call for an updated report from the PCIO, Rift Valley Province, the same was not availed to us as at the time of preparing this report. However, the PCIO did respond to our request on cases identified by the police as cases of special interest in the said province. The progress report therefore largely contains data which was reflected in the original report to the Hon. Attorney General save a few cases reflecting the current status as reported to this team by the Commissioner

of Police through Mr. Julius Ndegwa, EBS, DCP vide their report titled "Kenya Police, Update on 2007 Post Election Violence Offences as on 4th May, 2010". The team therefore notes that there is still need to carry out a further and comprehensive update of cases in the Rift Valley. It is therefore imperative that both teams appointed by the Commissioner of Police and the Attorney General converge in Nakuru on a date to be agreed upon for that purpose.

- 5. In regard to inquest files, the team notes with regret that most of these files still remain under investigation to date. There is an urgent need therefore to have the said files reviewed and directions given on the basis of the stage of investigations in each file.
- 6. The update exercise cannot be concluded exhaustively without the Commissioner of Police team and that of the Attorney General sitting together, preferably at the respective provincial CID offices, to review the progress of investigation in each province.

RECOMMENDATIONS

In view of the challenges and observations noted above, the Team recommends the following:-

- i) That, the Commissioner of Police be directed by the Hon. Attorney General in exercise of his power under Articles 156 and 157 of the Constitution of Kenya to fast track investigations into all the files that are still pending under investigations.
- ii) That in those cases where deaths were reported, specific attention be paid to their speedy investigation.
- iii) That upon conclusion of the investigations, the files be submitted to the Hon. Attorney General for appropriate directions.
- iv) That post election violence related case files in Nairobi province which are pending investigations and or pending before court where charges were preferred without reference to the Hon. Attorney General be forwarded to the Hon. Attorney General for review and directions.
- v) That the agencies involved in fighting crime make budgetary provisions in their financial estimates to cater for emergency situations in future to avoid the situation witnessed in the early part of the year 2008 in responding to the crisis and make sufficient

contingency funds available for a **continuous review of such cases** to avoid the current scenario where funds have to be mobilized from other vote heads.

- vi) That there is need to develop a common response approach by all the agencies concerned to avoid duplication of efforts.
- vii) All Law Enforcement Agencies should establish a liaison office for efficient and effective coordination of emergency and operational purposes to avoid reliance on adhoc teams that may be handicapped in responding to such crisis in a concerted manner. Lack of coordination greatly hampers efficiency and quick discharge of the respective mandates.
- viii) That there is need to provide equipment such as printers, photocopiers, and laptop computers to the Department of Public Prosecutions so as to enhance the delivery of service.
- review of these cases otherwise most files may lie unattended to without discovery thus denying the affected victims justice. It is therefore our

recommendation that a further 10 (ten) days review be undertaken with special focus to the Rift Valley Province in view of our observations above.
