Press Conference held on Monday by an official of the Prosecutor's Office

(...) For a period of 14 months or more, in what concerns Saif Al-Islam, the Prosecution has been monitoring the truth and collecting evidence in this regard. The original case or the case that was given attention by the Prosecution Office concerns the crimes that were committed against the Libyan people during the Revolution, for 8 months. We have spoken about the broad lines or the systematic criminal policies that were adopted by this regime in order to suppress the Revolution, as well as the legal characterisation of these crimes. We assure the Libyan people that the investigation in this case will come to an end and that the case will be disposed of [referred] in the near future, and its first hearings will be held, with God's will, in the first half of August. The case will be referred to the Accusation Chamber, which will view it and then refer it to Criminal Court – Appeals Circuit – in the Court of Tripoli, which is competent to view this case. I can cite the names of some defendants, if I can remember all of them; the defendants are: Saif Al-Islam Muammar Gaddafi, Abdullah Al-Senussi, Mansour Dao Ibrahim, Milad Salem Dhaman – of course Milad Salem Dhaman is Chief of Internal Security branch in Tripoli – Waleed Al-Toula – in the Internal Security Agency – Abdullah Al-Senussi – as everyone knows, Military Intelligence Chief – also Husni Al-Weheishi – Husni Al-Weheishi Al-Sadek */inaudible/*, in charge of Human Rights Affairs in the General People's Congress – Mohamed Belgasem Al-Zwei – Former Secretary of the General People's Congress – Al-Baghdadi Ali Al-Mahmoudi – Secretary of the General People's Committee – Abdul-Hafeez */inaudible* – Former Secretary of the General People's Committee of Finance and Planning – Mohamed Abu-Bakr Al-Deeb – former Registrar of the General People's Committee – Al-Hameed Mheida Ammar – Chef du Cabinet for Abdullah Al-Senussi and assistant in the Military Intelligence Office – and many Military Intelligence officers who used to work with Abdullah Al-Senussi – we should also point out that – also, Mohamed Ahmed Al-Sharif – Secretary of the Islamic Call Society; all of those, and others, had their role in the crimes that I have detailed to you earlier (...).
