Dear Madam,

It is my honour to contact you regarding the regularity of Mr Thomas Lubanga's attendance at classes given by the Faculty of Psychology and Educational Sciences of the University of Kisangani.

Mr Thomas Lubanga did indeed study occupational psychology from 1979 to 1985. He was successively awarded a *graduât* [first degree] in 1983 and a *licence* [second degree] in 1985. His studies were crowned with success. In the first year of the *graduât* programme, he obtained the mark of 58.6% (academic year 1979/1980); in the second year, after retaking the year, he obtained 62.86% (academic year 1981/1982); in the third year, his mark was 67.2% (academic year 1982/1983). He passed the last two years of his *licence* without resitting. We cannot find his mark for the first year of the *licence* programme, but he achieved 67.24% in the last year of the *licence* programme.

Bearing in mind the current pass mark for admission to postgraduate studies (DES/DEA) set by official directives, namely 65%, Mr Thomas Lubanga meets the entrance requirements. In view of the intellectual and moral qualities that, as his teacher at the Faculty, I know him to possess, and taking into account the report from the University of Kisangani authorities, I undertake to supervise his postgraduate studies and his DES thesis at the Faculty of Psychology and Educational Sciences.
