Re: Change in the remuneration scheme during new phase of the proceedings

I am writing in relation to the remuneration regime during the various phases of the proceedings before the Court as outlined in the "Registry's single policy document on the Court's legal aid system" ("Legal Aid Policy").<sup>1</sup>

Trial Chamber VII has set the date for the commencement of the closing arguments<sup>2</sup> in the case of the Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba et al. for 31 May 2016 and it is anticipated that they will continue until 3 June 2016, effectively ending the third phase on that day.<sup>3</sup>

As stipulated in the Legal Aid Policy, the period between the end of the closing statements and the judgment is considered to be a new phase during which only the services of Counsel are envisaged. Consequently, the applicable ceiling for remuneration is the monthly payment scale for Counsel of  $\in 8,221$ . This remuneration scheme shall remain in place until the Trial Chamber renders its judgment.<sup>4</sup>

The flexibility principle enshrined in the Legal Aid Policy leaves, however, the management of the above-mentioned sum at your discretion allowing you to use assistance of other team members, with the caveat that the combined "team remuneration" cannot surpass the maximum amount of  $\in 8,221$  allocated during this period.
