- 1. We want justice for the torture and atrocities Myanmar committed against us.
- 2. We want the Rohingya identity to be officially recognised.
- 3. We demand higher education opportunities and equal rights to higher education for our people. We want entrance to board exams.
- 4. We demand Muslim representatives in Government
- 5. We demand the right to practice our own religion and receive formal religious education. We demand freedom to practice religious festivals. E.g. Ramadan, Eid. We demand an end to taxation on our festivals.
- 6. We want all of our relatives who were unfairly arrested and are currently in Myanmar prisons to be freed.
- 7. We want equality for Muslim and non-Muslim populations in Myanmar.
- 8. We want freedom of movement through all Myanmar's cities and towns.
- 9. We demand compensation and reparations. We demand the Myanmar government return our properties, land, ornaments, which they have taken away forcefully.
- 10. We demand all unnecessary formalities during marriage, for example, for the end of monetary taxation on marriage. (In the name of tax to the government). We want enlisting of married couples with pictures with them.
- 11. We want all our family members to be together and to ensure proper justice for us, we demand 'no separation' within family members due to this current displacement.
- 12. Access to employment opportunities for our own people, the young and the next generation.
- 13. We demand citizenship for children who were born in Bangladesh during the forced displacement. They are our children, they are Myanmar's rightful heirs.
- 14. We want our right to assemble in the mosque.
- 15. We want free population counting and birth registration. We demand the right to be enlisted as citizens for each and every member of our family.
