Subject of the request

The Registry invites the competent authorities of the Republic of Kenya to inform the Court about the latest judicial developments that have taken place at the High Court of Kenya since Mr. Gicheru's and Mr. Bett's arrest and subsequent release. The Registry invites the authorities to provide the requested update by 31 March 2017, so that the Chamber may subsequently be informed of the developments.
