**Decision:**

*Whereas* article 39(7) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel,

Pursuant to article 15(7) of the Rules and Procedures of the Disciplinary Board and the Disciplinary Appeals Board,


The Disciplinary Board decides, after having heard the submission of Mr Djunga:
