He has received the *Ciardi Prize* of the International Society for Military Law and the Law of War and multi-year research grants from the Dutch Science foundation (NWO) on Post-Conflict Justice and Law after Conflict (*jus post bellum*).

His most recent monographs in the field of international criminal justice include *Justice as Message* (OUP, 2020) and *A Critical to International Criminal Law* (CUP, 2018).

He edited the *Law and Practice of the ICC* (OUP, 2015).
