I. SUBMISSIONS

- 1. The Prosecution requests to add the transcripts and translations of the enhanced audio recorded [REDACTED] of Witness P-0397 to be introduced as part his prior recorded testimony, pursuant to Rule 68(2)(c) or (d) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
- 2. As previously indicated,¹ the Prosecution seeks to submit additional material associated with P-0397's prior recorded testimony,² namely newly registered transcripts and translations that were produced pursuant to the enhancement of the underlying audio files. These could not be completed in time to include in the original application. These items have been disclosed to the Defence on 8 and 12 November 2021.
- 3. The Prosecution notes that only tracks one to four of audio recording KEN-OTP-0124-0018,3 and tracks eight to twelve of KEN-OTP-0124-00194 were enhanced.5 Consequently the new transcripts and translation listed in annex 1 only relate to those enhanced tracks. Each track correspond to one new transcript and one new translation.6 Therefore the Prosecution does not seek to "substitute" the former transcripts and translations which compile all the tracks of the two audio recordings,8 but rather to add the new material corresponding to the enhanced tracks only.
- 4. The Prosecution notes that of the nine tracks that were enhanced, and the corresponding transcripts and translations, only three contain significant content.⁹ The remaining material is included for completeness and to exclude the possibility of other potentially exonerating [REDACTED].
