#### I. Introduction

 The Registry hereby informs Trial Chamber X ("Chamber") of the appointment of Ms Leto Cariolou ("Ms Cariolou") as Legal Adviser to Witness D-0006 ("Notification of Appointment"), pursuant to rule 74(10) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules").

#### II. Classification
