## I. Introduction

1. On 27 June 2022, Pre-Trial Chamber II (“Chamber”) issued its “Order on the conduct of the confirmation of charges proceedings” (“27 June 2022 Order”),<sup>1</sup> in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Maxime Jeoffroy Eli Mokom Gawaka* case (“Case”), in which it *inter alia* adopted the “A-B-C” victim application procedure<sup>2</sup> and endorsed the guidance on the legal assessment of victim applications adopted by the Pre-Trial Chamber in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Yekatom and Ngaissona* (“Y/N Case”).<sup>3</sup> Specifically, in its 27 June 2022 Order, the Chamber instructed the Registry to:
  - a. Classify the applicants into three categories: (a) applicants who clearly qualify as victims (“Group A”); (b) applicants who clearly do not qualify as victims (“Group B”); and (c) applicants for whom the Registry could not make a clear determination for any reason (“Group C”);<sup>4</sup>
  - b. Transmit to the Chamber on a rolling basis and in un-redacted form, by way of a filing in the record of the Case, all complete applications on the basis of the A-B-C grouping, including any supporting documentation;<sup>5</sup> and
  - c. Transmit the Group C applications only “to the parties for observations pursuant Rule 89(1) of the Rules,<sup>6</sup> and legal representative as appropriate, with the necessary redactions to expunge the persons’ identifying information.”<sup>7</sup>

## II. Procedural History

2. On 22 March 2022, the Warrant of Arrest against Mr Mokom was made public.<sup>8</sup> On the same date, Mr Mokom made his first appearance before the Chamber.<sup>9</sup> At that occasion, the Chamber scheduled the opening of the confirmation of charges hearing provisionally for 31 January 2023.<sup>10</sup>
3. On 27 June 2022, the Chamber issued its Order setting out *inter alia* the admission procedure for victims' participation in the Case<sup>11</sup> and endorsing the guidance on the legal assessment of victim applications adopted by the Pre-Trial Chamber in the Y/N Case.<sup>12</sup>
4. Between 14 September 2022 and 21 November 2022, the Registry transmitted 281 applications categorised in Group A,<sup>13</sup> together with reports thereon.<sup>14</sup>

## III. Classification

5. The annexes to the present submission are classified as confidential *ex parte* only available to the Registry, in accordance with the 27 June 2022 Order.<sup>15</sup>


