1. The Common Legal Representative of Victims (‘CLRv’) hereby notes the ‘Fifth submission filed jointly by the Prosecution and the Defence on agreed facts’¹ (the ‘Fifth Submission’), as well as the ‘Prosecution’s request to submit lists of victims from the bar table’² (‘the Prosecution’s Request’).
2. The Fifth Submission contains 58 agreed facts, and the Prosecution’s Request contains 10 agreed facts.
3. The list of agreed facts contained in Annex A of the Fifth Submission relates to sunrise, sunset and prayer times and religious festivals, and the list of agreed facts contained in Annex A of the Prosecution’s Request constitute lists of persons killed or detained during the charged incidents in Kodoom and Bindisi, Mukjar, and Deleig.
4. Counsel indicates that the lists of agreed facts identified in both annexes do not negatively impact on the interests of victims.
