**TRIAL CHAMBER X** of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud*, having regard to Rule 141(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the ‘Rules’), issues the following ‘Declaration of the closure of the submission of evidence’.

1. On 14 July 2020, the trial in this case commenced.<sup>1</sup>
2. On 11 February 2022, the Office of the Prosecutor (the ‘Prosecution’) filed a formal notice on the completion of its presentation of evidence.<sup>2</sup>
3. On 6 February 2023, the Defence filed a formal notice also indicating the closure of its presentation of evidence.<sup>3</sup>
4. On 8 February 2023, the Prosecution filed a formal notice indicating that it does not seek leave to present rebuttal evidence.<sup>4</sup>
5. In light of the above, and pursuant to Rule 141(1) of the Rules, the Chamber declares the submission of evidence in this case closed.

**FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY**

**DECLARES** the submission of evidence to be closed.
