I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby transmits to the Defence 135 applications for reparations ("Applications") in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi* ("Case") in accordance with Trial Chamber VIII's "Reparations Phase Calendar" ("Chamber" and "Calendar" respectively).¹

II. Procedural History

- 2. On 27 September 2016, the Chamber convicted Mr Al Mahdi of the war crime of intentionally attacking protected objects under article 8(2)(e)(iv) of the Rome Statute ("Statute") and indicated that reparations would be addressed in due course.²
- 3. On 29 September 2016, the Chamber issued the Calendar, indicating that any applications for reparations must be filed by 16 December 2016.³
- 4. In November 2016, the Registry collected 22 applications for reparations⁴ during a mission in the field, all of which were assessed by the Registry as complete and linked to the Case.
- 5. On 2 and 5 December 2016 respectively, the Legal Representative of the participating victims ("LRV")⁵ handed over to the Registry's Victims

Participation and Reparations Section 107 and 5 further applications for reparations, all of which were assessed by the Registry as complete and falling within the scope of the Case.

6. On 16 December 2016, the Registry transmitted to the Chamber the unredacted versions of the Applications and informed the Chamber that it will file the redacted versions of the Applications on 22 December.⁶

III. Classification

7. Pursuant to regulation 23bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court ("Regulations"), the Applications are transmitted as confidential redacted annexes, since the applicants have raised security concerns regarding the disclosure of their identity to the Defence.

IV. Applicable Law

8. The present transmission is made pursuant to articles 68(1) and 75 of the Statute, rules 85 and 94 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulation 88 of the Regulations, and in accordance with the Calendar.
