#### I. Introduction

 In accordance with rules 13(1) and 176(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the RPE"), the Registry reports to the Three Judges of the Appeals Chamber appointed for the review concerning the reduction of sentence of Mr Al Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi ("the Three Judges") the responses received from the Republic of Mali ("Mali") and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland ("United Kingdom") following the notification to their authorities of the "Scheduling order for the review concerning reduction of sentence of Mr Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi"<sup>1</sup> (the "Scheduling Order") and the subsequent "Order on the filing of a response to the "Prosecution observations to the 'Scheduling order for the review concerning reduction of sentence of Mr Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi', ICC-01/12-01/15-392"<sup>2</sup> (the Second Order") issued by the Three Judges respectively on 7 July 2021 and 21 July 2021.

#### II. Classification

2. Pursuant to regulation 23*bis* (2) of the Regulations of the Court, the present submission is public as it refers to submissions filed with the same level of classification. The annexes are classified as confidential because they contain contact details of staff members of the Registry and of the Republic of Mali.

## III. Report on consultations with the United Kingdom and Mali

## 1) Consultation with the United Kingdom

3. On 7 July 2021, the Registry notified to the Embassy of the United Kingdom to the Kingdom of the Netherlands ("the British Embassy") the Scheduling Order.<sup>3</sup>

- 4. By email on 16 July 2021, the Embassy informed the Registry that the United Kingdom is not aware of any difficulty that would impact the hearing for the purpose of the review concerning reduction of his sentence ("the Hearing") scheduled on 21 and 22 September 2021. The Embassy indicated also that the competent services of the British Prison where Mr Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi ("Mr Al Mahdi") enforces his sentence will provide written observations related to the reduction of sentence on the criteria set out in rule 223 of the RPE by 30 August 2021 and does not intend to participate in the Hearing, without prejudice on the possible participation of the Home Office .
- 5. By the way of a note verbale of 21 July 2021, the Registry notified to the Embassy the Second Order, together with the "Prosecution observations to the "Scheduling order for the review concerning reduction of sentence of Mr Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi", ICC-01/12-01/15-392"<sup>4</sup> submitted by the Prosecutor on 19 July 2021 and the "Observations de la Défense sur le calendrier fixé par l'ordonnance ICC-01/12-01/15-392 »<sup>5</sup> submitted by the Defence of Mr Al Mahdi on the same day.<sup>6</sup>
- 6. On 26 July 2021, the British Embassy informed by email the Registry that the United Kingdom has no objection to the postponement of the Hearing to the week of the 27<sup>th</sup> September 2021 as suggested by the Prosecution.

## 2) Consultations with the Malian authorities

 On 12 July 2021, the Registry notified the Scheduling Order and its translation in French to the Embassy of Mali in Brussels ("the Malian Embassy").<sup>7</sup>

- 8. On 22 July 2021, the Registry transmitted to the Malian Embassy the French version of the Second Order and of the "Prosecution observations to the "Scheduling order for the review concerning reduction of sentence of Mr Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi", ICC-01/12-01/15-392", and the "Observations de la Défense sur le calendrier fixé par l'ordonnance ICC-01/12-01/15-392 ».8
- 9. On 26 July 2021, the Malian authorities informed the Registry that they have no objection on the dates proposed by the Prosecution to hold the Hearing on the week of the 27<sup>th</sup> September 2021. This communication was done through a note verbale from the Embassy sent by email to the Registry and a note containing the Observations of the Ministry of Justice and Human Rights delivered to the ICC Country Office in Bamako.<sup>9</sup>
