I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified confidential as it relates to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 28 March 2023, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani “Trial INCRIM package 115” containing 7 items, “Trial Rule 77 package 083” containing 17 items, “Trial Rule 77 package 084” containing 13 items and “Trial Reclassification to INCRIM package 011” containing 2 items.

4. “Trial INCRIM package 105” consists of documents that are being re-disclosed with lesser redactions and items used during P-2625’s testimony before Trial Chamber V in January 2023 which the Prosecution discloses as INCRIM.

5. “Trial Reclassification to INCRIM package 011” consists of documents used during P-2625’s testimony that are being re-classified. “Trial Rule 77 package 084” consists of documents used during P-2625’s testimony that the Prosecution considers material to the preparation of the Defence.

6. Finally, “Trial Rule 77 package 083” consists of call data records related to witness P-2328. Furthermore, this package includes items related to witness P-1422.
