

#### I. Introduction

1. The Registry submits an updated version of the E-court protocol for consideration by Trial Chamber VI (the "Chamber").

#### II. Procedural History

2. By way of email dated 27 September 2022, the Chief of the Court Management Section ("CMS") informed the parties and participants to the present case ("Parties and Participants") of three additional technical possibilities supported by the recently implemented evidence management tool (JEM).<sup>1</sup>

3. These amendments concern:

- The ERN numbering;
- The format of documents; and
- The format of audio/video material.

4. On 28 September 2022, the Chief of CMS informed the Chamber of the communication sent to the Parties and Participants.<sup>2</sup>

#### III. Applicable law

5. For the purpose of the present submission, the Registry has considered *inter alia* regulation 26(4) of the Regulations of the Court and regulations 10 (1), (4) and (5) of the Regulations of the Registry.
