1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified confidential as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 10 May 2023, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani "Trial INCRIM package 116" containing 13 items and "Trial Rule 77 package 085" containing 8 items.

4. The disclosure of "Trial INCRIM package 116" consists of the witnesses' read-back logs related to 13 trial witnesses for the certification process pursuant to rule 68(2)(b) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.¹

5. The disclosure of "Trial Rule 77 package 085" consists of items that are deemed material to the preparation of the Defence. It contains seven items related to witness P-2625's in-court testimony in the *Yekatom and Ngaissona* case, documents shown to the witness authorized to be disclosed in the *Said* case,² and one item related to trial Witness P-1825.
