I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The filing and its annex are classified as "Confidential" as they relate to evidence disclosed relating to *inter partes* communications and a decision of the same designation.¹

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

- 3. On 18 June 2023, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Maxime Mokom "Pre-confirmation Rule 77 Package 020" containing 15 items.
- 4. The Prosecution was ordered to disclose "all RFAs sent as well as responses relating to CDRs obtained by the Prosecution." On 16 June 2023 the Prosecution completed this disclosure. However, after conducting further checks against its inventory, it was discovered that 15 items had regrettably inadvertently not been added to those disclosure packages. The mistake was rectified immediately and disclosure executed on Sunday, 18 June 2023. The disclosure of "Pre-confirmation Rule 77 Package 020" consists of Requests for Assistance sent as well as responses relating to Call Data Records (CDRs).
