TRIAL CHAMBER X of the International Criminal Court, in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Al Hassan Ag Abdoul Aziz Ag Mohamed Ag Mahmoud*, having regard to Articles 64 and 74 of the Rome Statute (the ‘Statute’), issues the following ‘Order vacating the hearing scheduled for the delivery of the Trial Judgment’.

1. On 6 December 2023,¹ the Chamber issued a scheduling order announcing that its judgment pursuant to Article 74 of the Statute (‘the Trial Judgment’) would be delivered in a public hearing on 18 January 2024.
2. In light of the current health situation of Judge Antoine Kesia-Mbe Mindua, Presiding Judge of the Chamber, who is temporarily unavailable, the Chamber has no option but to vacate the hearing previously scheduled. The Chamber will convey updated information at the earliest opportunity.

VACATES the hearing scheduled for 18 January 2024.
